University outcomes and offers



Outstanding student achievements

- 100% of Year 12 QAHS students received early entry offers to Griffith University for 2014
- 99% of Year 10 students gained a Certificate III in Laboratory Techniques or Certificate III in Active Volunteering
- A group of QAHS students undertook the Health Studies Certificate at Griffith University concurrently with their Year 12 IB studies, achieving course credits.
- Students have been made tertiary offers in Queensland, interstate and overseas
- Excellent 2013 Extended Essays also resulted in four students making the BHP Science and Engineering finals with one QAHS student winning a \$3000 prize and a trip to the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair in Los Angeles, USA
- Year 11 IB Anticipated results in Psychology, Business & Management and Mathematics were particularly strong. Students can now “bank” this IB result and have more time in Year 12 for other subject work

Queensland Academies - Health Sciences Campus nurtures academic excellence through university partnerships, e-Learning innovations and community connections. Students are engaged in a broad range of opportunities. Just some of the QAHS successes during 2013 include:

Other Academic

- Year 11 and 12 Business and Management students participated in the *University of NSW Australian School of Business Economics and Business Studies Competition* with three students who finished in the top 2% nationally, awarded cash prizes.
- *University of NSW ICAS English Testing* - Our students in all year levels achieved well above the state mean in every facet of the testing components. Awards included 7 High Distinctions, 44 Distinctions and 117 Credits.
- 76% of students achieved a credit or above and 18 students achieved in the top 2% in the *Australian Mathematics Competition*.

Science competitions:

- An outstanding result in the *CSIRO CREST Research Awards*: 13 Gold, 1 Silver and 27 Bronze National Research Awards. Since the 1995 inception of the *CREST program*, more than a quarter of the National Gold Awards have been presented to QAHS students in the last five years. A phenomenal achievement and recognition of how our students are challenging what is possible when students are challenged to exceed their own expectations of themselves.
- QAHS was the winning school in the *Gold Coast Science Competition Senior School* division for the sixth year running. Student results included: 3 x 1st places, 3 x 2nd places, 2 x 3rd places, 3 x Highly Commended Awards.
- 7 students won prizes at the *2013 Science Teachers' Association Queensland (STAQ) Science Competition* with 2 students also receiving a bursary. 3 x 1st places, 3 x 2nd places and 1 x 3rd place prizes.
- Year 11 students sat the *University of NSW ICAS Science Test* with 51% obtaining a credit or better.
- Year 10 students entered the *Rio Tinto Big Science Quiz* with 50% obtaining a credit or better.
- All Chemistry students took the *Royal Australian Chemistry Institute (RACI) Chemistry Quiz* with 68% of Year 10s, 55% of Year 11s and 60% of Year 12s obtaining a credit or better.
- 45% of students received a High Distinction or Distinction in the *Australian Chemistry Competition* with two students awarded bursaries.

Languages

- Students participated in the *Chinese Language Teachers Association of Queensland Chinese Speech Competition* with a 3rd place in the Years 11-12 non-background speakers' division.
- *Griffith University Modern Language Teachers Association of Queensland (MLTAQ) French ab initio/B* results for QAHS: 2 x 1st Places, 1 x 2nd Place, 8 x Highly Commended Awards.
- Three students were recognised at the *Alliance Francaise Competition*, including a 1st prize.
- Year 12 student was awarded 1st place prize in the *Alain Duval French Competition* and received a trip to New Caledonia over the summer to further French language studies.

Music

- Two students were selected to participate in the *Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University State Honours Ensemble Program (SHEP) 2013*.
- One student was a participant in the *2013 Creative Generation – Queensland State Schools Onstage* at the Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre.

Sport

- A number of students were selected for regional and state sporting teams achieving Gold medals at state level in athletics and rowing.
- QAHS student received the *Layne Beachley Aim for the Stars Foundation Award*.

Study Tours

- Students of Mandarin undertook a 2 week study tour to China in the September holidays.
- Students of French engaged in a study tour and homestay for 6 weeks in France in December – January.
