Homework is always well completed by the due date, and all expectations of the subject are met. Student demonstrates independence with tasks and timelines.	Generally completes set work to the best of their ability in a timely manner and fulfils most expectations of coursework. Homework is completed by the due date and submitted as requested.	Shows some self-discipline towards completing set work but this lacks consistency. Effort is evident and some homework is completed and submitted by the due date as requested.	Rarely demonstrates self-discipline towards completing coursework and level of application is inadequate.

GRIT: is passion and sustained persistence applied toward long-term achievement, with no particular concern for rewards or recognition along the way. It combines resilience, ambition, and self-control in the pursuit of goals (Duckworth, 2018). **Growth Mindset:** “In a growth mindset, people believe that their most basic abilities can be developed through dedication and hard work—brains and talent are just the starting point. This view creates a love of learning and a resilience that is essential for great accomplishment (Dweck, 2015)”.
