Outstanding student achievements

- Outstanding results in the CSIRO CREST Research Awards: 7 Gold, 25 Silver and 63 Bronze National Research Awards. Since the 1995 inception of the CREST program, more than a third of the National Gold Awards have been presented to QAHS students in the last eight years. A phenomenal achievement and recognition of how our students are challenging what is possible when students are supported to exceed their own expectations of themselves.
- Excellent 2017 Extended Essays also resulted in a student finalist for the BHP Billiton Science and Engineering Awards and the Intel Science & Engineering Fair USA.
- 100% of Year 10 students gained a Certificate III in Laboratory Techniques or Certificate III in Active Volunteering.
- Students have been made tertiary offers in Queensland, interstate and overseas.

International Baccalaureate

- The Queensland Academies offer the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme which is an internationally recognised pre-university level qualification. It allows graduating students to study at Australian tertiary institutes as well as overseas universities.

Science:

- QAHS was the winning school in the *Gold Coast Science Competition Senior School* division for the tenth year running. Student results included: 4 x 1st Place, 4 x 2nd Place, 3 x 3rd Place and 2 x Highly Commended.
- A number of students were judged award winners across a range of categories for their scientific and mathematical investigations work in the *Science Teachers' Association Queensland (STAQ) Science Competition* with students awarded 1st Place in three of the available five categories. Students also received two 2nd Place and one 3rd Place awards.
- All Chemistry students took the *Royal Australian Chemistry Institute (RACI) Chemistry Quiz* resulting in 15 High Distinctions, 11 Distinctions and 13 Credits.
- Eight students were accepted into the *National Youth Science Forum (NYSF)* and attended the annual NYSF camp.
- QAHS won the regional level of the *Engineering Super Challenge* sponsored by the University of Newcastle with the highest combined score in Queensland and placed 2nd in the state finals.
- A number of medals were won by students involved in Science Olympiads for Biology, Chemistry and Physics.
- Two students were awarded Gold medals and six students awarded Bronze in the *Education Perfect Science Championships*.

Languages

- Success in the *Language Perfect French* (1-50 students category) saw students presented with Elite, Gold, Silver and Bronze Awards.
- *Griffith University Modern Language Teachers Association of Queensland (MLTAQ) French ab initio/B* results for QAHS: 2 x 1st Places, 1 x 2nd Place and 1 x 3rd Place.
- *Alliance Française Song and Poetry Competition* results for QAHS: 2nd Prize, Prix francophone.
- Students participated in the *Griffith University Modern Language Teachers Association of Queensland Chinese Speaking Competition* with students awarded 1 x 1st Place, 2 x 2nd Place, 2 x 3rd Place and 1 x Highly Commended.
- Students participated in the *Queensland University of Technology Mandarin Speaking Competition* with 1 x 1st Place, 1 x 2nd Place, 1 x 3rd Place and 3 x Merit Awards.

Competitions:

- All students sat the *ICAS English Test* achieving well above the national mean in every facet of the testing components with results including 3 High Distinctions, 18 Distinctions, 68 Credits and 27 Merit Awards.
- All students sat the *Australian Mathematics Competition* with 78% of students obtaining a proficiency level or better with 59 students obtaining a High Distinction or Distinction.
- Year 11 and 12 Business Management Students participated in the *University of NSW Australian School of Business Economics and Business Studies Competition* with results including 5 High Distinctions, 12 Distinctions and 26 Credits.
- QAHS was awarded 1st Place in the *Griffith University Law Students' Association High Schools Mooting Championship*.
- QAHS was awarded 1st Place in the *Gold Coast Debating Competition* final and awarded "Most Successful School" for the highest average points across all teams in the competition.

Music

- A number of students were successful in AMEB, eisteddfods, auditions and other performance events. A student was selected as a runner-up for the Gold Coast Airport Artistic Development Grant 2017.

Sport

- A number of students were selected for regional and state sporting teams achieving medals at state level in athletics.

Creativity, Activity, Service (IB CAS)

- Students were engaged in a broad range of rich co-curricular programs including: *The Kokoda Youth Challenge* in Papua New Guinea, *QUT Future Leaders*, *Interact*, *Model United Nations*, *Mooting*, *Duke of Edinburgh*, *National Constitutional Convention*, *United Nations Youth Forum*, *Gold Coast Junior Council*, *Homeless Connect*.
